

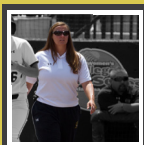

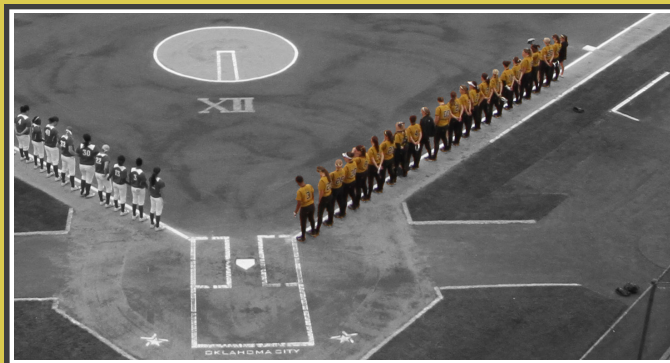
In both camps...

Registration Information

Fees include all meals as well as a camp T-shirt and any awards/certificates won at camp. You can send your completed registration, along with a nonrefundable \$100 deposit to the address listed at the bottom of the registration form or register online at www.mutigers.com. Please visit the camp section of the Missouri athletic website to register. Confirmation, along with detailed camp information, will be forwarded to you upon receipt. The cut-off date for registration is two weeks prior to camp start date. Mail-in registrations must be post-marked 2 weeks before deadline. There will be a late registration fee of \$25 within 13 days of the start of the camp and \$50 within 6 days. We will not accept any registrations past these dates: June 10th or for Development camp and June 17th for Tiger camp. A switch from resident to commuter must be made at least 1 week prior to check-in or you will be charged full resident fee.

Cancellation/Refund Policy: Your fee, less a \$100 nonrefundable deposit, will be refunded if you cancel your enrollment two weeks prior to the camp start date. At any time after this date, refunds, less the \$100 nonrefundable deposit, will be made for medical reasons only. Requests for refunds must be accompanied by a signed notice by the applicant's physician. Campers who must leave during the camp due to illness or injury will receive a prorated refund based on the number of days of participation. No refunds will be given to campers who voluntarily leave camp or who are sent home for disciplinary reasons. Camps are open to any and all entrants limited only by age, grade level, gender and/or number.

Parents/Legal Guardians: This indemnification form must be completed and signed by a parent or legal guardian in order for the camp registration to be complete.

Incomplete forms will be returned by camp administration.
